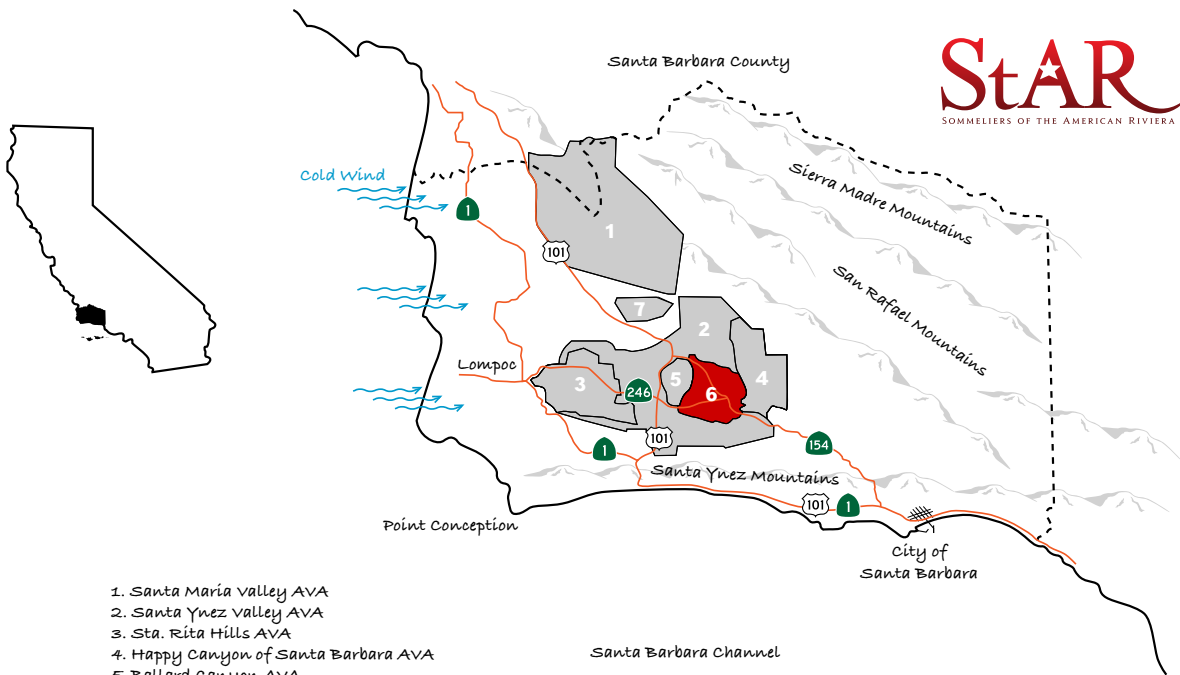
Casita de Bravo

This wine exhibits flavors and aromas of red currant, dried cherry, black cherry, black plum, red licorice, black licorice, sea salt, dried thyme, dried rosemary, sandalwood, black tea, balsamic glaze, dried red roses, dried violets, cured leather, leafy underbrush, tobacco and iron-rich earth. Dark ruby in color with light ruby hues, this medium-bodied wine showcases ripe and dried fruit with vibrant acidity, firm tannins, layers of complexity and a long, savory finish. Hits all the marks of a classic Sangiovese from central Tuscany. Outstanding!
